The Misrimal Navajee Munoth Jain School of Architecture was established by the Tamilnadu Educational & Medical Trust (Team Trust) in the year 2012. Misrimal Navajee Munoth Jain Engineering College Provided financial assistance & land measuring 2 acres on which 50,000 Sq.ft of School of Architecture building is Constructed.

The Misrimal Navajee Munoth Jain Engineering College was established by the Tamilnadu Educational and Medical Trust (TEAM Trust) as a polytechnic institution in the year 1984 and it was upgraded into an Engineering College in 1994. Sri Lalchand Munoth, Chairman of the Trust came forward with a donation of Rs Ten Laksh in 1984 and with a further donation of Rs Twenty Five Lakhs in 1994 and made it possible to realize the dream of Late. Dr.C.L.Metha, Secretary of the Trust and himself to establish a technical college in Chennai. The college was named after the Chairman's father Late Sri. Misrimal Navajee.

About The Course

Bachelor of Architecture(B.Arch) is a professional Course Spread over 10 Semesters(5 Years) with 7 Semesters of the taught programme (Lecture & Studio), 2 Semesters of professional training and 1 Semester of Thesis. The Course Covers a wide range of topics like Art, History, Environmental Science, Structural Engineering, Building Services, Computer aided design etc.

On Successful Completion of the course and registering with Council of Architecture, graduates become Architects and are eligible to set up an Architectural Practice of their Own. Alternatively graduates can join architectural firms or architectural departments of government or Statutory body, Opportunities in related fields include interior design, graphic design, Commercial art, architectural Journalism and architectural teaching.

ADMISSIONS

B.Arch admissions eligibility

- As per Council of Architecture regulations, a candidate applying to any school / colleges of architecture in India should have 50% marks in 10+2 or equivalent examination with minimum 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and 40% score in NATA, i.e. at least 80/200, for consideration of admission into first year of 5 year B.Arch. Degree Course.
- The admissions shall be carried out by the Competent Authority i.e. Government or University, based on the marks obtained in NATA and the qualifying examinations in the ratio of 50:50.
- Candidates having 50% aggregate marks in 10+2 or equivalent examination with minimum 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics only are eligible for admission to B. Arch Course.
